As part of the conformity assessment procedure, CE-marked products are checked to ensure that they actually comply with the applicable EC directives and safety standards. Internal documentation includes hazard analysis and risk assessment, while external documents include operating or assembly instructions.

The workshop covers the structure and evaluation of internal and external documentation created in accordance with EC directives.
